Good morning everyone!

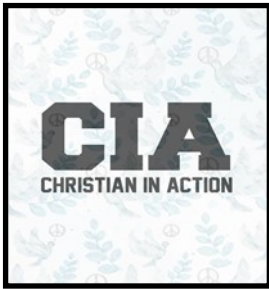
Welcome everyone to our service. 2020 is well underway and promises to be a year of new growth and moves of the Spirit as we serve each other and our community with the love of Jesus.
